

### **Acknowledgment of Leadership**



World Health Day is a global health awareness day celebrated every year on 7th April, to spread the awareness among the people, the theme for World Health Day 2024 is "My Health My Rights".

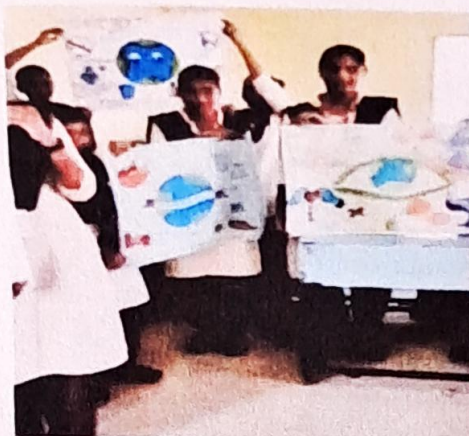


## Basic Life Support Training Session at Shriram Multi Speciality Hospital 27.02.2024

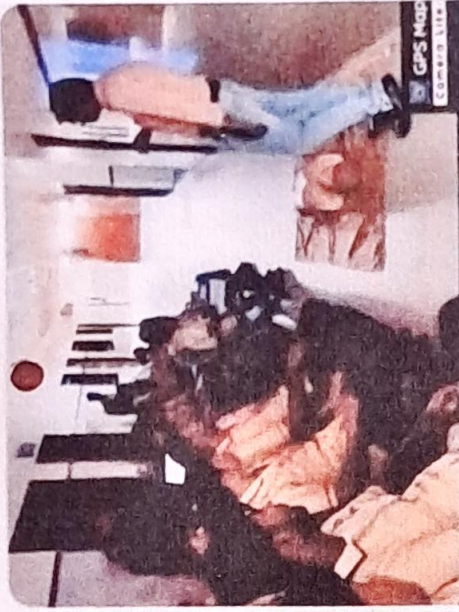
